They moved from Vermont/New Hampshire back to Elmer's hometown of Lovell by 1916 then to Harmony about 1920 and were living there in C/1930. They moved to Hartland in 1939 where Ethel was living with her son in C/1940 and her daughters Ruth & Virginia while Elmer was living and working on a dairy farm in Falmouth where he had a milk route. She was listed in C/1940 in Hartland as a saleswoman for a corset company. She began serving as the Hartland Librarian in 1966 and was presented with the Boston Post Gold Cane of Hartland in 1992.

“Webster began work at an early age, taking over his father's milk route. He worked for Bath Iron Works during World War II. He drove a truck for St. Johnsbury Trucking until he lost his leg. In 1947 he received auto repair training in Hallowell and went to work for Central Maine Motors in Waterville. He later opened his own business on Alpine Street in Oakland and was self-employed for many years. He was a longtime resident of Oakland. He learned to fly in his late 40s and flew his final flight for his 90th birthday.”

Ida graduated from Harmony High School Class of 1936, Ring School of Psychiatric Nursing in Arlington, Massachusetts Class of 1938, Symmes Arlington Hospital with affiliations at Boston Lying In Hospital for Obstetrics in Boston, Charles Chaplin Hospital for Contagious Diseases in Providence, Rhode Island, Boston Floating Hospital for Pediatrics in Boston (1938-1941) and received her Nursing Degree in 1941. She served as an Ensign in the U. S. Naval Nurse Corps from 1942-43 and as a 2nd Lt. in the U. S. Army Nurse Corps from 1943-1944. She was Superintendent of Nursing and Assistant Hospital Administrator and Office Nurse at Scott-Webb Memorial Hospital in Hartland from 1947-1970.

"Dick moved with his father and sister Marjorie to Stoneham during high school. He graduated from Fryeburg Academy in the Class of 1941. He worked with his father and grandfather logging with a team of horses, running logs on the Saco River and in the slab mill in North Lovell. He and Anna bought their farm on Fish Street in 1948. He went on to raise an award-winning herd of

Holsteins. He was a Maine Green Pastures winner in 1953. He was a charter member and the Fire Chief for Saco Valley Fire Department and a life-time member of the Maine Farm Bureau, serving in various official capacities with Anna during their farming years. He was a life-time member of Fryeburg Fair, serving as a trustee since 1963. He was awarded the Fryeburg Distinguished Alumni Award in 1993.”
