In 1932 they purchased their house on Moore Street during the Great Auction of 1932 noted as Lot 26. NO. 49 WEBB STREET: (Moore Street) Approximately 8,600 square feet of land with two story frame cottage having seven rooms, bath, electricity with barn attached. They were living there in C/1940.
