At the time of their marriage in 1885, they were both living in Boston where he was employed as an Expressman. They moved to St Albans by C/1900. (An Expressman refers to anyone who has the duty of packing, managing, and ensuring the delivery of any cargo. During the 19th century, an Expressman was someone whose responsibility it was to ensure the safe delivery of train's gold or currency which was secured in the 'Express Car'. The job included guarding safes or other strongboxes or coffers against outlaws and memorizing the safe's combination until delivery.)

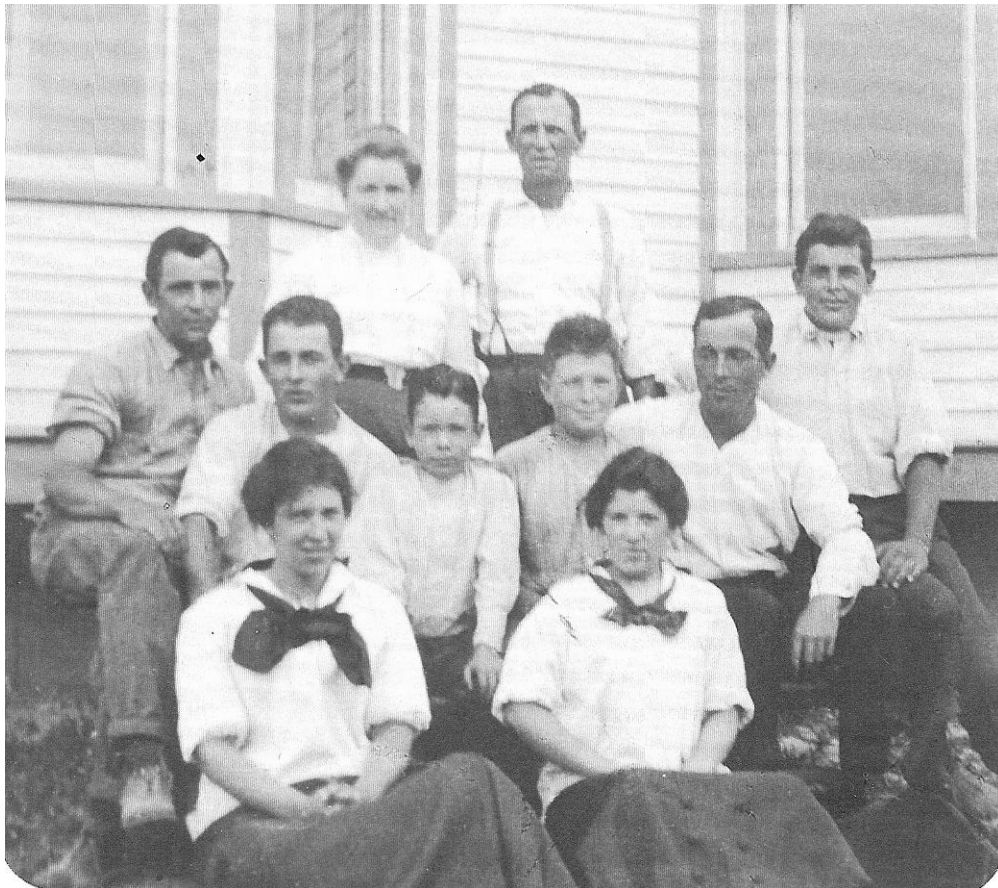

Etta's mother Sabiah moved to the Hartland area sometime after she and Sander divorced in 1900 possibly living with her sister Nellie McGray who had married Fred Palmer in 1901 and had moved to St Albans at the future Gee Farm. Although it is still unclear where Sabiah was living in C/1900, she died in Hartland at 34yrs old on 21 Mar 1904 of cancer and is interred at Pine Grove Cemetery with Nellie & Fred and her mother Emily (Lewis) McGray. Emily is a sister of George W. Lewis; father of Preston Lewis. (See Lewis Family)

Etta had remained in Fort Fairfield in C/1900 living with her paternal grandparents, Ruel & Julia (Sawyer) Bennett, at 8yrs old. She was living in the home of Stuart & Myra Goodwin in St Albans at 18yrs old in C/1910 noted as a "Hired Girl" and was also noted as a resident of St Albans when she married Harold in 1912. It is also unclear where her sister Elsie was living in C/1900 but she was living with her Uncle Frank & Aunt Nellie (McGray) Palmer in St Albans in C/1910 until she married Frank McCormack in 1919. (See McCormack Family)

Harold & Etta resided in St Albans after they married then moved to Wellington by 1919 living there in C/1920. They moved back to Hartland by 1924 where they first lived on Hubbard Avenue and eventually moved to Pleasant Street by C/1930. Harold operated a Fire Wood business and later was a fur dealer.

Kenneth graduated from Hartland Academy Class of 1938. "After high school, Kenneth attended Lincoln flying school in Lincoln Nebraska where he received an FAA flying license. After school he went to work for Pan Am Airways flying out of Honolulu, Hawaii. After a short stay with Pan Am he went to work for Glen L Martin in Maryland as a flight line mechanic on the B-26 Bombers. In 1940 Kenneth went to work at Olmsted Air Force Base in Middleton, Pennsylvania as an aircraft mechanic. He worked there till the bombing of Pearl Harbor, when he transferred to Hickam Air Field in Honolulu. After a stay at Hickam he returned to the states and joined the US Air Force. He was assigned to the 15th Air Force Squadron on B-24 bombers. He was stationed in Italy where he flew several missions over Europe as a flight engineer and gunner. After his return from the Air Force, Kenneth went back to work at Olmstead Air Force Base until 1965 when he moved to Hill Air Force Base in Ogden, Utah where he worked until his retirement in 1980 with 40 years of service."
