Inscription: "MARY COSTON died June 15, 1838 age 53 years, wife of Samuel Coston". Her Great-Great Grandfather John Tuttle arrived from England aboard the 'Angel Gabriel' which was destroyed off the coast of Pemaquid, Maine during the Great Hurricane of 1635. He made his way to Dover, New Hampshire where he became a large land owner. His great-great grandson James Tuttle II moved to Maine soon after 1800.

They eventually moved to Palmyra by 1880 living on the Warren Hill Road where their homestead was just past the current Davis Road on the right a couple of miles past the Hartland Town Line. She graduated from Hartland Academy Class of 1902. Harry was a Barber and they were living in Hartland in C/1910. After they divorced she began working at the Hartland Public Library in 1916 becoming the Head Librarian in 1924 until her retirement in 1966. She was a pianist for the silent movies shown at the Opera House/Town Hall. She remained in Hartland her entire life and never remarried. Harry moved to Rockwood and married 2nd to Mabel (Brown) Dearborn on 26 Oct 1915 and they were living in Newport in C/1920 where she died soon after. He married 3rd to Ora E. Miller on 5 Dec 1921 in Old Town and they were living in Bangor C/1930 & C/1940. He remained there until his death.

"He had been a resident of Hartland since 1939 and had previously been a farmer at Palmyra. He was a Past-Master of the Corinthian Lodge, AF & AM, a Past-Patron of the Evening Star Chapter, OES, a Seventh Degree Member of the Hartland Grange and a Member of the Modern Woodsmen of America."

Joshua and Aurelia (Starbird) Coston at their home in Palmyra, Maine. The dog's name was "Prince". These people were Hazel Coston Corey's paternal grandparents. The horse's name was "Dandy". The Costons were engaged in farming. He died quite young, perhaps due to an unpleasant personality.

Their children were Lincoln (married an Emma from Prince Edward Island); Ellen (married Abner Linnell); Joshua Fremont (father of Hazel, wife of Melissa); Harry (married Sada Free).
