He first volunteered for service in the Civil War in 1862 at 17yrs old with the 24th Maine for 9 months. After moving to Kings Camp, Michigan with his brother Noah where they were working at a logging camp, he reenlisted with the 19th Maine in 1864. Following the war he moved to Moose Lake, Minnesota, living there in C/1870 with his brothers John & Isaiah at a lumber camp. He returned to Hartland in 1871 where he purchased land in North Hartland previously owned by his Uncle Sampson Hart. After selling the property in 1880 and moving to Pittsfield, they returned to North Hartland by 1892. They remained there where he was a farmer for most of his life until they moved in their senior years to St Albans in 1925 living next to their daughter Pearl. Following Thankful's death, he returned to Hartland, living with his son Fred Hart when he passed away.
