He was raised in Sidney. He and Rhoda moved to the Waterville/Fairfield area living in Somerset Mills by C/1860 with their family before moving to Hartland by 1865 where he became the first Pastor of the Free Baptists which formally organized in Hartland on February 25, 1868. He began operating a dry goods & groceries store next to the former Peleg C. Haskell house on Commercial Street by 1870. Soon after 1876, they purchased the Haskell house living there in C/1880 just before his death. They had taken in their 2 granddaughters Idell & Iola Merrow following their daughter Fanny's death in 1872 and raised them in Hartland. Rhoda was noted on the 1883 Map of Hartland Village at the same house and was living there with her granddaughter Iola (Merrow) Hatch and her husband in C/1900 until her death.

Fanny is presumed to be the same person noted as "Anna" in C/1860 as their daughter at 13yrs old. She is noted as mother of Idell & Iola on several documents as Fannie or Fanny Bowman as is their father John. She was noted in C/1870 in Smithfield as Fannie Merrow with her 2 daughters listed but not her husband John. Her gravestone notes she is the wife of John H. Merrow and she is buried in the same cemetery as his parents. Her death coincides with the birth of their son Frankie and may have been from complications of the birth. John remarried to Delana Ellis by C/1880 and remained in Smithfield while their daughters Idell & Iola were living with her parents in Hartland in C/1880 and were raised by their grandmother Rhoda Bowman.

They remained living with her grandmother Rhoda Bowman after they married on Commercial Street in C/1900 where he was a Train Station Agent in Hartland for the Sebasticook & Moosehead Railroad in the late 1890s. He left the railroad in 1902 and they opened a store at Reverend Bowman's former store location for a couple of years. Following Rhoda's death, they sold the house and store in November of 1905 and moved to Long Beach, California and were still living there in C/1920 & C/1930.

He appears to be the same unnamed person from an 1870 newspaper article about a fire on July 25th at Robinson's Saw Mill on Indian Stream in St. Albans which noted, "During the excitement, a son of A. Bowman was badly injured by being run over by a person on horseback who was riding around giving the alarm." His mother's obituary also notes, "One of her sons met with a sad accident that disabled him for 2 years and she tenderly cared for him day & night."

Wesley's death was reported by his brother Dr. Arthur Bowman who had come from Lewiston to attend to his failing health. Following his death, Mae remained at their Academy Street home in C/1900 noted as a Widow with her 3 daughters. She remained in Hartland in C/1910 with her 3 daughters. Also living in the household with her were Birney Moore and his sister Mary Moore noted as boarders. She and Crystal moved in with her daughter Freda and her family in Augusta by C/1920 then moved with Freda and the family to Orono soon after where she died.

According to his granddaughter, Arthur was teaching at Hartland Academy when he met the 2 elder Bowman Sisters. Freda served as Town Librarian from 1911-1913 before they married. He went on to become a nationally known educator and expert in Maine agriculture and agricultural education at the University of Maine at Orono including his service as Director of Extension, Dean of the College of Agriculture and Director of the Agricultural Experiment Station. Deering Hall at UMO was named for him shortly after his retirement.
