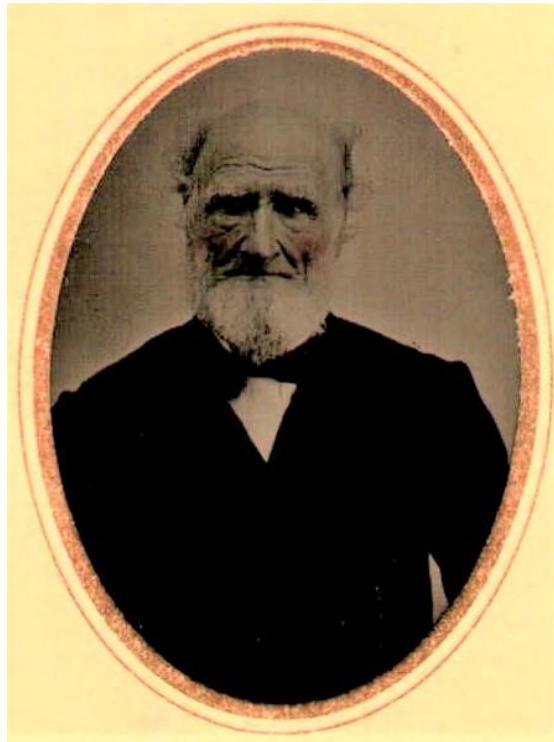

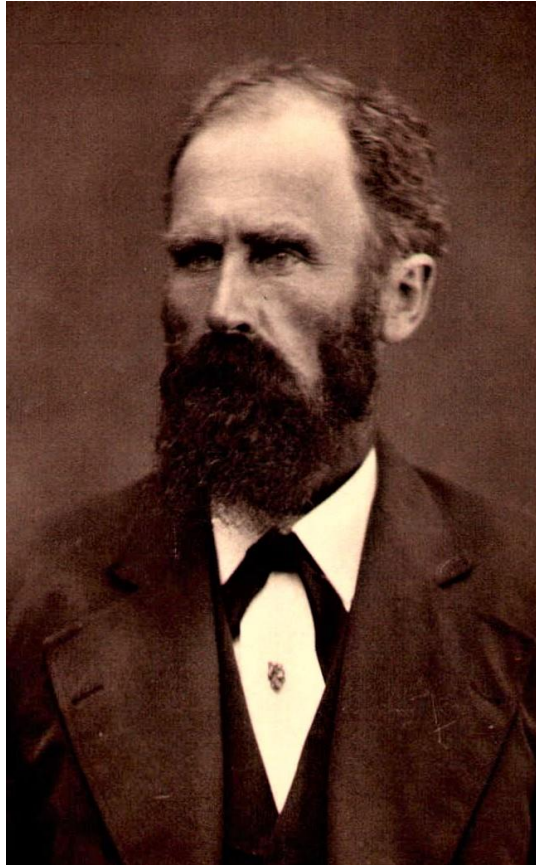

He was a science teacher at Hartland Consolidated Schools, served as Principal for Hartland Academy, received a Master's Degree in Education from the University of Maine and served as Guidance Counselor at Nokomis Regional High, retiring in 1992. Vaughn was involved in education for 34 years and served as the area State Representative for 10 years. Vaughn loved to play golf, was an avid Boston Red Sox fan, and was a very active member of Grace Linn United Methodist Church

in Hartland. He was a member of the Hartland-St. Albans Lions Club for over 50 years, receiving the Melvin Jones Fellowship Award, the highest honor that Lions Club International can bestow. He was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1992."

"One of Helena's most prominent early day citizens and builders, John Stedman, died on March 29th at the age of 61 years. He was the founder of the Stedman Foundry, located where the Helena Sand & Gravel Company plant is today, and had lived in the city for 30 years. Much of Stedman's foundry work may still be found about the city today [Iron Front Hotel]. Stedman, who served as Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Montana, A.F. & A.M., in 1877-78, was on a picnic with Mrs. Stedman when he had a heart attack and died immediately. John was born in Hartland, Maine on February 11, 1836, joined the California gold rush, and later resided in British Columbia. He came to Helena in 1870, and in 1873 he married Alice Armor of Pennsylvania, and built the house on the west side. He went into the foundry and machinery business in 1877. He operated the plant alone until 1890, when a stock company was organized and he was made manager." Alice moved to California following John's death with her daughters Clara and Blanche living in Palo Alto in C/1910 and in Bolinas with Blanche in C/1920.

Dr. Arnold Stedman.

One of the Maine men who still revisits his native State, is Dr. Arnold Stedman whose Portland residence for a number of years has been at 7 Carroll street.

He was born at Hartland, in Somerset county, Maine, and attended the St. Albans academy. He fitted for Waterville college at the Maine State Seminary at Lewiston, and entered college in September, 1862, but almost immediately left to answer the call for volunteers during the Civil war, and enlisted in the 22d Maine volunteers. He was made orderly sergeant of Company K, and served in the 19th Army corps under General Banks. He was engaged at the siege of Port Hudson, the battle of Irish Bend and in other battles. He was mustered out in August, 1863. He then began the study of medicine in the office of Dr. John Benson of Newport, Maine. He took the course of lectures in the medical department at Bowdoin college and graduated from the Berkshire Medical college at Pittsfield, Mass., in 1865. He practiced medicine at Dexter, Penobscot county, Maine, until 1870, when he went to Denver, where he has been a successful practitioner since. He was a member of the school board of district No. 1 in Denver, from 1878 to 1890 and was for nine years of that period the president of the board. This was during the period when an efficient school system was established in Denver, and the city owes Dr. Stedman a debt of gratitude for the work he brought about at that time.

Dr. Stedman received an honorary degree from Colby college, and was the founder of the department of medicine of the University of Denver (Methodist) and was professor of medicine therein for twelve years. He has been the presi-

dent of the State Medical association, vice-president of the American Medical association, and a United States pension examiner for four years.

Dr. Stedman married Miss Clara Brown of Portland, Maine.

"Preston left Maine at the age of 20 for Fort Benton, Montana where he engaged in mining in Jefferson Gulch for a number of years. He came to Lewiston, Idaho with the Salmon River Survey in the spring of 1870. He arrived in Dayton, Washington three years later where he was one of the first settlers of that section of Columbia County when it was merely a station of a very few houses. He first settled on the Duncan Farm in Mustard Hollow, later moving to the home place 4 miles east of town, where he spent 33 years. He then purchased the Reuben Watrous home on 407 Spring Street in Dayton. He was a charter member of Columbia Lodge No. 26 A.F. and A.M. constituted 11 Oct 1877, a charter member of Pioneer Association of Columbia County organized 17 Mar 1893, and a member of the Christian Church."
