They were living in Palmyra in C/1860 with Charlotte noted as his wife and their son Charles at 1 month.

He enlisted April 23, 1861 for the required 3 month enlistment obligation. The 1st Maine was mustered into service May 3, 1861 at Portland with its primary duty in defense of Washington, D.C. from June 1st until August 1st. Joseph noted in the 1890 Census Special Veterans Schedule he was discharged from service in June of 1861 due to sunstroke. Most of the remaining regiment was mustered out August 5, 1861 at Portland. His regiment is engraved on his gravestone along with his service year of 1861. His death certificate note his birthplace and his parents' names.
