John Burton, Sr b. 1821 Clinton d. 17 Aug 1889 Hartland (Fullers Corner Cemetery) æ 68yrs m. c1849 Nancy A. Wright *d/o Jessie & Sally Wright originally of Pittston* b. 1829 Phillips d. 3 Nov 1912 St Albans (FC w/John) æ 83yrs *They were living in Clinton in C/1860 and moved soon after 1863 to Hartland where they were listed in C/1870 with their 4 youngest children. Nancy remarried to James LaBree, widower of Hannah Worthing* (See Worthing Family), on July 14, 1894 in West Pittsfield. James was 84yrs old at the time of their *marriage and she at 65yrs old. Following James' death in 1904, she was living with her daughter Parintha in St Albans in C/1910 noted as Nancy LaBree at 81yrs old.*

In the 1900 Census, Nancy reported she had 5 children born with 5 living but in the 1910 Census she reported 7 children born, 5 living. No information has been found on the other 2 children.

He lived with his parents until his father's death and remained in Hartland with his widowed mother in C/1900. He and his mother were living with his sister Parintha in St Albans in C/1910. He remained there with his nephew Ralph Philbrick until his death. Obituary notes burial at Fullers Corner Cemetery but no stone.

In 1898, Allen leased the former Fairgrieves Carding Mill located on the future Hubbard Avenue where he opened a furniture store and began providing undertaking services. His son Elmer joined him there in the family business in the early 1900s.

In 1914, they leased the former C. H. Skinner Store Block on Commercial Street from Mrs. Mary (Linn) Fuller. They added hardware sales and dropped the furniture business operating as A. R. Burton & Son Hardware & Undertaking.

In 1919, they purchased the building and had added full service gasoline pumps at the store. Elmer took over the business following his father's death in 1932 but dropped the undertaking part of the business.

Allen was very active in town affairs serving as a Town Selectman and a member of the Hartland School Committee as well as beginning and sponsoring the A. R. Burton Speaking Contest at Hartland Academy which continued after his death until 1968. Adeline's younger sister Nellie Woodbury married Allen's brother Willard. Adeline is also a twin sister of Athelene Woodbury who died at 6 years old and is buried with their parents at Nevens Cemetery.

They had no known children.

She was noted as a telephone operator residing in Hartland on their marriage certificate. She was listed as a nurse on her death certificate by Dr. Charles A. Moulton. Her father was noted as her Undertaker. Hermon remarried in 1924 to Frieda Kirkendall and moved to Saco.

He was noted as an Embalmer at his father's business on their marriage certificate in 1912. They purchased the former Archibald Linn residence on Commercial Street at the 1932 Auction of American Woolen Company properties including former Linn Estate properties. They took over his father's store for a few years but did not continue with the undertaking part of the business. In 1930, he opened a heating oil business which he operated in the area for several years. He later sold the store to Rae Fuller Randlett around 1941.
