He was living in Canaan in 1814 when he and his brother Samuel Wheeler were mustered into Captain Holt's Company under Lt.-Col. Waugh's Regiment; both listed as Musicians. He & Eunice were living in Canaan in C/1820 where he was listed as Jonas Wheeler, Jr and his presumed father listed separately as Jonas Wheeler.

He was taxed in Canaan in 1827 before moving to West Hartland by C/1830 where they remained until his death. He gave Massachusetts as his birth place in the 1850 & 1860 Census in Hartland. Eunice applied for a widow's pension following Jonas' death with his service with Captain Holt noted. She was living with her son Simon Wheeler and his family in Hartland in C/1870 & C/1880 until her death.

Their 6 oldest children's names, birth dates & birth places were included in Canaan Vital Records before they moved to Hartland where the 4 youngest children were born.

They were married by his elder brother Richard Gower (Fullers Corner Cemetery) noted as Mr. Osgood Gower and Miss Louisa Wheeler, both of Hartland. They were living in West Hartland in C/1850 with their 2 oldest children listed with the Gower surname. 3 more children were born to them in Hartland and following the birth of their youngest child in 1857, they moved to the section of Westbrook known as Saccarappa by C/1860 listed there with their 5 children under the Gower surname. In C/1870, they were again listed in Saccarappa with their 4 youngest children under the surname Gore but in C/1880 were listed in Saccarappa as Gower with Richard, George & Esther in the household.

April 18, 1881 article from the Portland Press Herald notes "In Saccarappa, 10th Inst., Mrs. Louisa, wife of Osgood Gore, age 56 years, 11 months."

January 5, 1883 article from the Portland Daily Press notes "In Saccarappa, Jan. 3, Osgood Gower, age 72 years.

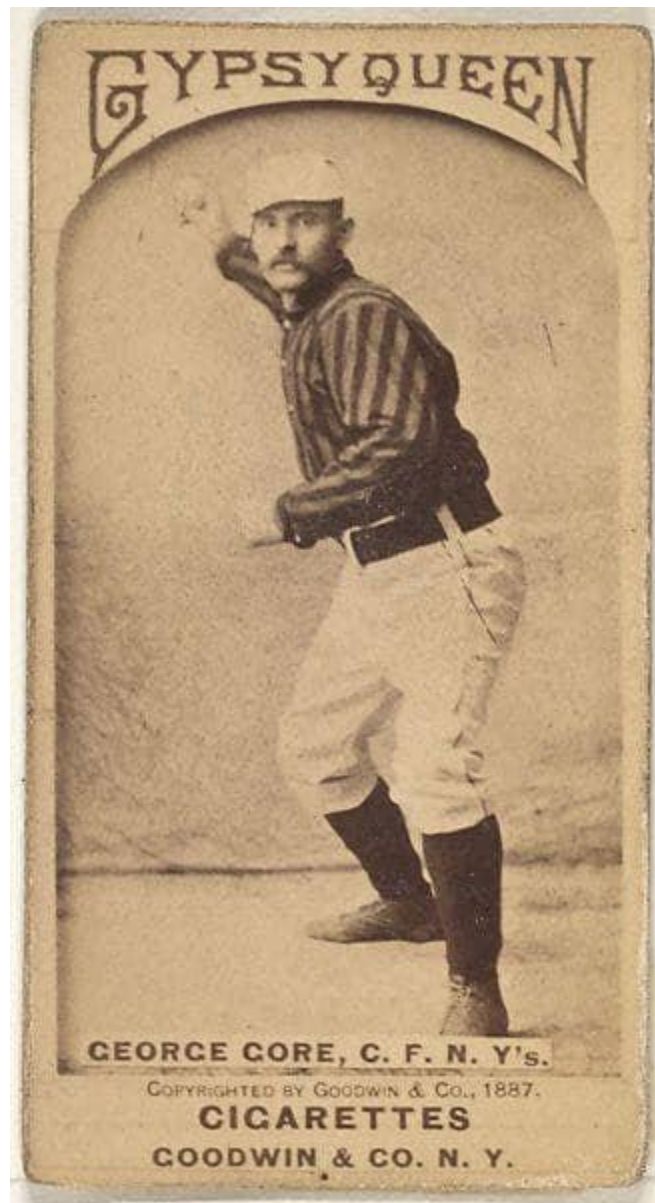

Noted with parents in C/1860, C/1870 & C/1880. He became a professional baseball player playing from 1879 to 1892 as George Gore. He was Centerfielder for the Chicago White Stockings, New York Giants and the St Louis Browns setting numerous hitting and

fielding records. Several future publications very generally refer to his early connection to Hartland and later in Saccarrappa but with no specific mention of his parents' names.

They were living in Hartland in C/1880 before moving to Rice Lake, Wisconsin living there by C/1900 and noted there again in the 1905 Wisconsin State Census. Following Lowell's death, Mary was living with her son Collins in C/1910 in Rice Lake, Wisconsin noted at 73yrs old and widowed.

"Mrs. Wheeler died Monday after a long illness. She was a Christian and a kind and loving wife and mother. She leaves to mourn her death, besides numerous friends, two sons. - The Rice Lake Chronotype, Thursday, May 4, 1911.

A receipt notes Collins Wheeler purchased 6 burial plots at Nora Cemetery, Rice Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin. The obituaries of Mary, Florence and Viola state they were interred there however a visit to the cemetery in 2022 by his Great-Grandson Dan Wheeler revealed no existing markers for any family members so those noted at the cemetery are presumed interments.

"Mrs. A. P. Wheeler died at the hospital in Rochester, Minnesota as the result of an operation on Friday, March 31. Mrs. Wheeler had been in poor health for some time and was advised to go away for an operation. The remains were brought to this city (Rice Lake) and the funeral held Monday from the family residence on the south side. The remains were interred in Nora Cemetery." - The Rice Lake Chronotype, Thursday, April 13, 1911

He was living in Hartland with his parents in C/1880 working at the Linn Woolen Mill before moving with his parents to Rice Lake. He & Viola were living in Rice Lake, Barron County, Wisconsin in C/1910 after they married with their son Emery at 1yr old. Following Viola's death, Collins was living with his widowed brother Ahira in C/1920 in Rice Lake, Wisconsin also noted as a Widower along with his son Emery at 10yrs old but not his daughter Bertha. He was living in Wyocena, Wisconsin in C/1940.

"The residents of the south side (Rice Lake) were shocked to hear of the death of Mrs. C. Wheeler on Sunday. She left a girl baby only a few days old." - The Rice Lake Chronotype, Thursday, September 28, 1911.

Her birthdate as Bertha May Wheeler was noted in Barron County, Wisconsin Birth Records and generally referred to a few days later in her mother's 1911 obituary. She was eventually taken in by her maternal Aunt Lily Ferris and was living in the household of Lily and her 2nd husband William Zunke in C/1920 in Raymond, Washington noted as their daughter Bertha Zunke at 8yrs old. She was then listed as Bertha M. Wheeler and noted as their niece in C/1930 at 18yrs old in Chambers, Washington but used her adopted Zunke surname as noted on her marriage certificate which lists her birthplace as Rice Lake and her adopted parents as witnesses. She was noted in her brother Emery's 1988 obituary as Bertha Palermo living in White Salmon, Washington.

WELL KNOWN RESIDENT DEAD

Isaac S. Wheeler Succumbs After
Illness

The death of Isaac S. Wheeler, a well known citizen, occurred Wednesday evening of last week at his home 10 Jewett street. The funeral services were held last Saturday at ten o'clock with Masonic rites. Rev. Charles H. McElhinney preached the funeral discourse. The pall bearers were Forest Cross, Delbert Matthews, Delbert Nason, Edward Ford, George E. Sampson and L. W. Gerrish. A special car conveyed the remains to Madison, where they were placed in the tomb until spring, when interment will be in the Forest Hill cemetery.

Mr. Wheeler was born in Hartland sixty-three years ago last October, the son of Wesley C. and Ethel (Stedman) Wheeler, both natives of that town. He received his education at Hartland Academy. At the age of twenty-one years, he went to St. Paul Minn., where he took charge of the

large coal office of his uncle. This firm at that time supplied the entire city with coal and wood. About three years afterward, Mr. Wheeler returned to Maine, and with his father became engaged in farming in Norridgewock. This was on the farm where Horace Withee now resides. A few years later, they sold the place and his father and stepmother, formerly Miss Josephine Richardson of Hartland, and half-brother, Eugene W., moved to Oregon.

Mr. Wheeler then entered the employ of William Brackett of Norridgewock, in the store now owned by Brackett & Russell. He remained there for three and one-half years.

On May, 1891, he was united in marriage with Miss Martha A. Morse of Madison. They commenced their married life on their newly purchased farm on Ward Hill, in Madison. For twelve years, Mr. Wheeler was engaged in agriculture. Owing to the ill health of his wife, they moved to La Junta, Colo. During his residence in that city, he was employed in the car shops of the Santa Fe Railroad. The change of climate failed to restore the health of Mrs. Wheeler, and they started back to their native state, but she died before reaching home.

One year later, in company with Elmer Davis, he carried on a fish market in Madison. On disposing of this property, Mr. Wheeler came to Skowhegan to work for the Somerset Traction Company. His services for that corporation terminated on account of failing health, November 30th, last after a period of fourteen years.

On July 17, 1907, he was happily married to Miss Minnie E. Russell of Skowhegan. She is the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. I. B. Russell.

In the summer of 1909, Mr. Wheeler was severely injured while coupling cars at Cole Brook, and never afterward fully regained his former robust health. He was again injured July 17, 1918, when two electric cars collided just above the residence of E. E. Hurd on the Lakewood road. Since that time his health had been failing rapidly.

Mr. Wheeler was a man of sterling qualities and could be thoroughly relied upon in any position of trust and responsibility. He was a member of Quinnesisset Lodge, No. 109, I. O. O. F., of Norridgewock and of the Somerset Lodge, No. 34, F. A. M., of Skowhegan. He made many warm friends in this town and in Madison and also among the traveling public.

The large concourse of friends and the many beautiful flowers bore silent expression of the respect in which he was held. For immediate relatives he leaves to mourn his death, a widow and a half-brother, Eugene W. Wheeler of LaGrande, Oregon.
