Woodbury Family

John Woodbury was born in 1579 in Burlescombe, England and came to the New World by 1627 with his first wife Joan and their son Humphrey Woodbury, born in 1611 in England. John remarried to Agnes Napper in 1627 in Salem, Massachusetts. His Great-Great Grandson Moses Woodbury moved from Salisbury, Massachusetts to New Gloucester, Maine about 1764 with his wife Sarah (True) and their family of 6 children including their oldest son Nathaniel Woodbury, Sr.

They were living in New Gloucester in 1800 with their children. By the time of the 1810 Census, they had already moved to West Hartland listed near Huff Hill (aka "The Gore") possibly with several of their younger children likely including their sons Samuel, Charles, Nathaniel Jr & Moses and daughters Charlotte, Nancy & Sarah.

Nathaniel, Sr is the only Woodbury listed in Hartland in the 1810 Census so it is presumed it was soon after this when their son Israel Woodbury also settled in West Hartland at Huff Hill and their son Isaiah Woodbury settled in West Hartland at Goodwin Hill as noted in the 1912 Somerset County Register. No further records have been found for their sons Samuel or Nathaniel Woodbury, Jr. Their son Charles Woodbury is only found in the deed reference below which Anna is recorded signing.

They moved to West Hartland around 1812 and were first noted there in C/1820. As noted in the 1912
Somerset County Register, "He was among the earliest families and settled on the place where Wallace
Goodwin now lives where he put up a log cabin. He is said to have been the first to begin work in
clearing the land on the hill." He later signed the petition for Hartland to incorporate as a town in 1820.
Thankful is a sister of Hannah Libby who married his younger brother Moses Woodbury.

Rose was living with her widowed brother-in-law Ezra Withee, Jr in C/1880 along with her brother Fred Woodbury before she first married. Her death certificate from Palmyra notes her place of interment as the "Old Yard" with her Undertaker noted as A. R. Burton of Hartland. The Daniel W. Ham Family Monument at Ireland Cemetery only notes Daniel & Elmer's death dates but there are 3 individual undated foot stones inscribed as "Husband, Wife, Baby" which his only known wife is <u>presumed</u> to be Rose.

They had no known children. (C/1910 also notes 1 child born, 0 living) Charles was adopted and raised by his Uncle Isaiah B. Littlefield and his wife Mary W. Goff. They moved from Waterville to Hartland with Charles in 1871 where Isaiah operated the Hartland House until his death in 1882. Charles married 1st to Eva (Unknown) in 1883 but soon abandoned the marriage, divorced and remarried to Rose.

Charles & Rose were living in Hartland in C/1900 before moving to Palmyra on Outer Elm Street just over the Hartland town line by C/1910. Mary (Goff) Littlefield remarried to Isaac Stedman III (See Stedman Family) in 1886 and was living with Charles & Rose in C/1910 after Isaac's death in 1908 and noted as Charles' adopted mother.

Soon after Rose's death, Charles remarried on June 3, 1917 to Nettie Bernice Emery of Bradbury residing at the same home in Palmyra in C/1920. In 1919, they opened a branch of the Iona Mill Ends Company at their house; a mail order outlet store specializing in various cotton goods and cloth remnants. Following Charles' death, Bernice operated the store until late 1924.
