

Vincent was the 1st of 3 Goforth Brothers to move to Maine followed later by Robert & George. He was living with his 1st wife Lena in Springfield, Missouri in C/1920 noted as an Undertaker. Shortly after Lena and their infant son's death in 1921, he moved to Portland where he continued in the undertaking business. Chrystal was also living in Portland at the time working as a Registered Nurse at Maine General Hospital. They married in 1923 at her mother and step-father Millard Blake's new home on the Hartland Road in St Albans. They returned to Portland for about a year before moving to St Albans where he was admitted into the Maine Undertakers Association on August 27, 1925.

They moved to Hartland in 1926 residing first on Academy Street where he, with Chrystal's assistance, soon opened his first funeral parlor in town at a currently unknown location. By C/1930, they had moved to Elm Street and in 1932 purchased the former James Fuller, Jr residence up the street where they moved their family and their Goforth's Funeral Parlor business. He also had an ambulance & hearse service for the business which his brother George came from Missouri in 1934 to help him operate. In October of 1932, Chrystal became the first Registered Nurse to work at the newly opened Scott-Webb Memorial Hospital in Hartland.

By 1937, they had purchased her step-father's original homestead on the Webb Ridge Road in St Albans and moved their family there while Vincent continued operating the funeral parlor business in Hartland for a few more years. They were still living on the Webb Ridge Road in C/1940 and operating the funeral parlor before they sold the Elm Street location to Dr. Charles Norcross by 1942. In 1944, they moved with their daughters to St Petersburg, Florida living there until Vincent's death in 1977. Chrystal returned to Hartland where she passed away in 1989 at Sanfield Nursing Home which had replaced Scott-Webb Memorial Hospital.

Among several of the local organizations in Hartland they were members, Vincent was a Charter Member of Hartland American Legion Post #141 organized in 1930 while Chrystal was one of 15 Charter Members and first elected President of the Hartland American Legion Post #141 Women's Auxiliary organized in 1937. Chrystal is the twin sister of Carroll Milford McPheters.
