The low wagon bed made it easier to load barrels of potatoes or other heavy freight.

According to his family, he was named after his father's brother Alexander Donald McDougall (his spelling with 2 "L" s). Alexander was a Sargent in the 1st Maine Cavalry, Company K. He was called "Sandy" by those in his unit and was apparently a bit of a character as told by the stories about him in the Unit history and at reunions after the war. He was one of only five Company K enlistees who made it through from 1861 to the end of the war serving in about 30 battles during the conflict. He was noted as a skilled swordsman according to the records.

Following Donald's death, Emma remarried to Lauren Fremont Potter, a widower neighbor, on August 19, 1900 and were married by his father. They moved to Drummond, New Brunswick living there in the 1901 Canada Census with her children Lillian & Ernest McDougal and Woodford Joseph Potter (1896-1969), an only child from Lauren's first marriage. They moved back to Limestone by 1904 and were noted there in C/1910. They had four children together; George Everett Potter, Annie Mae Potter (m. Harvey J. Hughes), James A. Potter and Mary Ellen Potter (m. Howard R. Weaver). Emma & Lauren became known to their grandchildren as "Gram & Gramp Potter".

"Lauren was born December 21, 1861 in Drew Plantation to Reverend George Everett Potter and Abigail Tryphena Trott. His mother died when he was about a year old and his father remarried to Jane Morgan. The family moved to Limestone about 1879. Lauren's 1st wife Ida May Knox died in 1896 at 27yrs old of Consumption (TB) when their son Woodford was about 2 months old." Lauren passed away on April 24, 1948 at 86yrs and is interred with Emma at Maplewood Cemetery. It will be noted the spelling of his first name deviates numerous times in various documents throughout his life but for reference purposes, "Lauren" has been used for this document.

They were taught to respect their mother by both their parents. Mary was the organist at the First Baptist Church for many years, taking over from her mother, Valti, after her years of service."

"Mary had worked for Baxter Canning Company, Dexter Shoe, Edwards Company and for Topper Badger Trucking. One of Mary's enjoyments was going out to eat and trying new restaurants. She loved to go around up country with her husband and loved ones. She loved family reunions and going to yard sales. Many times you would find her at home sitting in her rocking chair reading her Bible. She loved the Lord and was a member of the Hartland First Baptist Church. She played both the piano and organ faithfully there for over 40 years."
