"He moved to Hartland at the age of ten and finished his education in the Hartland schools, graduating from Hartland Academy with the Class of 1928. For many years he was employed by H.C. Baxter & Bros. and later was promoted to Plant Engineer at their freezing plant in Corinna, known as the Snowflake Canning Company, until it burned in 1968. The following year he was appointed Town Manager for Hartland and served in that position for seven and a half years, retiring on his 65th birthday. He continued to be active in the town affairs, serving as Building Inspector during the completion of three community block grants. He was a past member of the Hartland Planning Board and also served as the Plumbing Inspector. Edgar was a past member of the Board of Trustees for the Hartland Library and served on the Board of Directors of the Scott-Webb Memorial Hospital for 18 years. He was a Past District Deputy Grand Master of the Hartland Lodge of Odd Fellows, I.O.O.F. #101 and belonged to the Hartland & St. Albans Lions Club and the Triple C. Couples Club."

"She was educated in Hartland schools and graduated from Hartland Academy in the Class of 1930. She attended Beal College in 1932. She served as an assistant Teacher, 1953-1954, at the Hartland Primary School. She worked for many years in the offices of Snowflake Canning Company, Irving Tanning Co. and Northeast Shoe Co. and also served as Librarian in the Hartland Library for nine years. She was an avid reader and history buff. She was a member of the Maine Federation of Women's Club; past President and member of the Outlook Club; a member of the Triple C Couples Club; and an associate member of the Grace Linn Memorial United Methodist Church.
