was a farmer and well known cattle drover noted in his obituary driving thousands of head of cattle to market over the course of his 50 years in the business of raising cattle. He was active in early town affairs serving as a Selectman for several terms. He was later on the committee formed to build the Town Hall. Hannah's parents were early settlers at West Hartland. The original Thompson Homestead would eventually be destroyed by fire in the summer of 1951.

He was a livestock dealer in Hartland and was operating the Hartland House in 1904 before he moved his family to Mt Vernon, Washington soon after 1908 living there by C/1910 where he also established himself as a successful livestock dealer.

Elva never remarried and moved to Seattle with their 2 daughters by C/1930 where she remained until her death.*

He later operated an automobile business in Pittsfield with his son-in-law Paul Coolidge.

Paul came to St Albans with his parents from Livermore soon after his birth where he attended grammar school then graduated from Maine Central Institute and Morgan's Business School at Waterville. He and Ina moved to Pittsfield in 1919 where he was in the auto business with his father-in-law Frank Thompson for many years. Following Ina's death, he remarried to Alice M. Parkman on December 10, 1928. They had 1 child, Elizabeth "Libby" Coolidge (1930-2021) who married John "Jack" Whalen.
