They had moved to Hartland by 1904 when he had an accident driving a team of horses while working for the Linn Woolen Mill resulting in a serious back injury when he was tossed from the cart and run over by its wheel. He and LaDora and their children were living with her parents in Cambridge by C/1910 then returned to Hartland by 1913 where he later began working at American Woolen Mill by C/1920 and again in C/1930. They were still living in Hartland in C/1940 on Park Street (Canaan Road).

"Norma graduated from Hartland Academy, Class of 1939. Norma had been employed throughout the years as a medical secretary, working for Dr. Pierce and Dr. Briggs. She enjoyed square dancing and snowmobiling, and had been a member of Sno-Devils Snowmobile Club in St. Albans. Weston attended St. Albans and Corinna schools. He was a Veteran of World War II and served in the U.S. Navy aboard the Flag ship U.S.S. Columbus in the Pacific Theater. He was employed at Irving Tannery in Hartland as a Buffer Machine Operator for 22 years, retiring in 1985. He was a member of the Steeves & McCormack Post 141 American Legion in Hartland."

"Harlan retired from the Edwards Company in 1990 after 34 years of dedicated employment. Since 1962, Harlan was a devoted member of the Corinthian Lodge #95 A.F. and A.M., and the Anah Shriners of Bangor, as well as a member of the Hartland Historical Society. Harlan's love for his family was unmatched, his smile and humble, caring demeanor captivated anyone he met. He never missed his daily crossword, was an avid golfer and reader, always loved a 'good flashlight', traveling in his motor home, and was proud to have kept his driver's license until he turned 95. He was a recipient of the Boston Post Cane for being Hartland's oldest male citizen."

He recalled after graduating from Hartland Academy in 1945, he went to trade school in Chicago to learn about radios where he saw his first TV which was the size of a refrigerator. He was drafted into the service wanting to be in the Army Signal Corps, but was instead put in Medical Corps. He received medical and first aid training and observed operations in the operating rooms where he sanitized instruments. He worked in

the Army Hospital in Pennsylvania where he also escorted blind patients on the train to the School for Blind in Boston. He was discharged in Bethesda, Maryland in 1947.

Ina married 1st to Francis "Shannie" Fernald of Corinna; 2 children, Linda & Diana Fernald. "Ina graduated from Skowhegan High School Class of 1947. She was employed as a bookkeeper for several area businesses in Skowhegan and Hartland, retiring in 1980. In the 1970s she was an active member on the Board of Directors for Scott-Webb Hospital and Waterville Osteopathic Hospital."
