General Notes for Ireland Cemetery by Bruce A. Fowler

It was originally known as the Village Cemetery and was also later referred to as the Pleasant Street Cemetery. There are approximately 520 +/- interments listed on about 400 headstones. It is likely the land was owned by James Moor as Minutes from early Town Meetings in the 1820s refer to provisions to be made for a cemetery in the Village on land owned by him but the exact location is unclear in the records. It is currently unknown when or why it was renamed as Ireland Cemetery but property next to the cemetery and a large 90 acre tract of land across the street from the cemetery was later owned by Captain Joseph Ireland by the late 1830s.

The first known interment was Abraham Moor of Goffstown, New Hampshire who died February 15, 1823 at 74 years old. He and his wife Esther Walker are the parents of Sally Moor, wife of William Moor who first settled in what became Hartland (then part of St Albans known as Fairhaven) in 1802. Abe & Esther and several other members of their family came to join William & Sally from Norridgewock where they had first relocated.

The last interment was Miss Helen Moor Smith on October 6, 1983 at 94 years old which also officially closed the cemetery. Helen is the 6th generation of Moor Family buried here. She is the daughter of Elmer Smith & Florence (Moor). Florence is the daughter of Amasa Moor & Frances (Lancey). Amasa is the son of James Moor & Dorcas (Wiggin). James is the son of William Moor & Sally (Moor) making Helen the G-G-G-Granddaughter of Abraham Moor. At her request, Helen's dog "Chummy" was buried next to her with his own gravestone.

Confirmed records of men interred at the cemetery who served in military duty include 1 Revolutionary War Veteran and 5 War of 1812 Veterans. There are 21 Civil War Veterans who survived the war (A 22nd surviving Civil War Veteran, Morrill Annis, is listed on his parents' stone but is interred at Pine Grove Cemetery). An additional 8 men who died while serving in the Civil War are memorialized mostly with cenotaphs.

Of the known 520 +/- people listed, 104 of them died before the age of 10; over half of them under the age of 5 years old. Another 57 people died between the ages of 11-20 years old. On the other end of the age spectrum, 46 people lived to be at least 80 years old and 17 people lived to be at least 90 years old.

The oldest interment is unconfirmed but thought to be Ruth (Perkins) Berry-Merrill who was 102 years and 4 months old at the time of her death in 1934. She is the widow of Allen Berry and Jesse Merrill. Ruth was born in Hartland in 1831 and is the daughter of Hobbs Perkins & Lois (Spencer), also interred here.

The 2nd oldest is Uzziel Withee recorded at 97 years, 4 months, 18 days; born in 1765 and died in 1862. At the time of his death, Uzziel was one of the oldest surviving Revolutionary War Veterans in Maine and the Nation.

The youngest at the time of their deaths include several interments of infants who did not live past their first day of birth including 2 sets of twins.

The cemetery was completely restored by the Hartland Historical Society in 2013. It is to be noted several stones are missing after being broken and discarded over the previous decades and never replaced.
