They were living with her parents in St Albans in C/1850 & C/1860 with her father Jonathan Carr, noted as Head of Household. They were living in the same place in C/1870 but Alfred was then noted as Head of Household with her parents listed living with them. They remained in the same home in C/1880 with their children with Alfred noted as a Farmer. Following Alfred's death, Almena is noted living in the household of her grandson Selden Martin I in St Albans in C/1900 where her son Charles also lived. It appears this is the same homestead.

"As quietly and peacefully as fade the stars from sight, so Mrs. Almena Martin, of St. Albans, passed from her earthly life Wednesday, August 5th. Mrs. Martin was born in Vienna, Maine, April 24, 1821, and was the only child of Jonathan and Ploomy (Seavey) Carr. At twenty-five years of age she was married to Alfred Martin, whom she survived by twelve years, and seven children, six of whom are still living, blessed their union. George Stanley the second son is in San Francisco. The other five were with her in her last hours. Since the death of her husband, Mrs. Martin has resided with her eldest son, Charles Granville Martin, on the old Martin homestead in St. Albans. The other children are: Mrs. Nathan L. Meands of Kingfield, Mrs. Charles H. Bonney of St. Albans, Edgar H. Martin of St. Albans, and Fred W. Martin of Hartland. Everything that love and care could do, was done to stay the time when she was to pass to a better and brighter home beyond. The funeral was Friday at one o'clock. The Rev. William Lang of Pittsfield, officiating. The flowers from friends and relatives were many and beautiful. The interment was in the family lot in the Prescott (Lang) Cemetery." He located his business office two buildings down toward town. Vivian did books for the new business and often cooked for the hired men at the logging camp on St Albans Mountain.

"Selden graduated from Hartland Academy Class of 1939 then Becker College in 1941. He was an avid outdoorsman. He was a private pilot who flew into remote

ponds to fly fish. He worked for his father as business manager before becoming Town Manager of St Albans and then Pittsfield. He later worked for E. J. Prescott of Gardiner and then George A. Caldwell Pipe & Fittings of Waldoboro.”

“Virginia graduated from Hartland Academy Class of 1945. Before marrying Selden, she taught in a one room school house. Over the remaining years she raised her family while running an egg farm, working at Northeast Shoe first stitching shoes then working in the office. She then went to work for Hughes Insurance after getting her license. After moving to Florida, she studied to be a CNA and cared for Alzheimer’s patients who loved her tender loving care.”

Raymond believed in community service and served on the Board of Directors for MSAD 48 and the Sebec Valley Hospital.
